Summary:

Collaboration is most likely to occur with connection and on a needs basis.

There need to be connection and communication between the various TAFE libraries for collaboration to occur.

Bodies such as VATL and TRIG provide the opportunities for communication. Collaboration can then occur when more than one library has a similar need.

Examples:

PD sessions both for library staff and for general staff. Knowledge sharing for any particular project. Swapping ideas/services/staff Upskilling staff Consortia purchasing
